### Remote Learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

Given the high rates of COVID-19 infections at the moment, we are preparing to provide remote learning for any children forced to self-isolate. **If children are unwell with the virus, then we will not be expecting them to work from home.** However, it is highly likely that many self-isolating children, will be well enough to continue learning, given both the mildness of the symptoms in children in the vast majority of cases and the range of circumstances in which a child may be forced to self-isolate.

In the event of absence due to self-isolation related to COVID-19, we shall issue a 3-day remote learning paper pack. This pack will either be posted or hand-delivered to your home. Remote learning for any school days beyond the first three will be provided in the form of links to activities online. The school will contact you during the first three days of your child's period of self-isolation in order to ascertain any support that you may need in accessing the online learning from day 4 onwards.
