



Reception - Summer 2 - All Around The World

Prime Areas	<p>This half term we will be comparing and contrasting life in the UK to life in another country. We will use new knowledge and vocabulary to form well-constructed sentences and opinions in class discussions. We will also spend some time asking questions about moving to year one, and will discuss the changes that will happen in school.</p>	<p>This half term, we will be looking at the different skills we have learned throughout the year in our PE lessons and self-assessing where we think we need more practise. We will also ensure the children have developed the necessary skills to manage the school day ready for year one.</p>	<p>As this will be our last half term in Reception, we will spend a lot of time thinking about the changes that are coming in school. We will talk about the transition to year one, what to expect from a new year group and meet our new teacher! We will summarise what we have learned throughout the year about our feelings and friendships to help us in year one.</p>

Specific Areas	<p>We will be focussing on the story of Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne in our Literacy sessions this half term. We will become familiar with the story using a story map and actions, then we will change parts of the story to create our own version. We will also read The Earth Book by Todd Parr and create posters to inform people about how to look after our planet.</p>	<p>This half term, we will continue to build our confidence with numbers to twenty. We will also learn about different numerical patterns. Towards the end of the half term, we will be learning about different types of measuring such as length, weight and capacity. We will look at a range of ways that we can measure and use comparative language to talk about what we find.</p>	<p>In our 'All Around the World' topic, we will be focussing on travelling vehicles, holidays, weather in other countries, how to look after our planet and what it is like to live in another country or come from another country. In our RE lessons, we will learn about Windrush Day, and read the story of Floella Benjamin's journey to England from the Caribbean.</p>	<p>During this topic, we will be looking at different art from around the world. We will use some of this art to create our own versions to display around the school. We will also spend some time listening to and watching African music and performances. We will create our own dances and musical compositions to accompany these.</p>
