


Reception - Autumn 2 - Before Me

Prime Areas	<p>During our carpet times and group discussions, we will be developing our vocabulary by exploring the differences between old and new objects.</p> <p>We will also develop our question asking skills to gain information about what life was like for my teacher's Nanny when she was in Reception.</p>	<p>This half term in our PE lessons, we will be continuing to develop our confidence with different modes of moving. We will also be using these movements in different ways such as by completing obstacle courses, balancing and dancing to different types of music.</p> <p>We will also be continuing to have daily Handwriting lessons.</p>	<p>This half term we will be spending some time learning about making the right choices. We will talk about rules and why we have them, what some rules are when we are not at school and why it is important to make good choices in our daily lives.</p>

Specific Areas	<p>We will be focussing on the story <i>Whatever Next!</i> by Jill Murphy in our Literacy sessions this half term. We will be writing our own recounts of a journey to the moon and a set of instructions about what you will need to take to the moon.</p> <p>The children will be using their developing phonics knowledge to blend and segment simple CVC words with increasing independence.</p>	<p>During our Maths lessons this half term, we will begin learning about the process of adding and subtracting.</p> <p>We will compare groups of objects and numbers and look at changes within five.</p> <p>We will also begin learning about measuring time by using time-specific words and ordering different sequences such as our school day.</p>	<p>In our afternoon sessions, the children will learn about when our parents/carers were little, when our Nannies or Granddads were little, differences between old and new, toys and changes over time. We will also have discussions about our world and how we can make healthy, environmentally friendly choices.</p> <p>In our RE lessons, we will learn about Diwali and Christmas and why these are special times.</p>	<p>For our topic of <i>Before Me</i>, the children will have the opportunity to play in our toy museum role play area.</p> <p>We will be creating black and white or colour pictures based on old and new photos using different media.</p> <p>Through our learning about Diwali and Christmas, the children will also learn a range of songs and dances for each celebration.</p>
