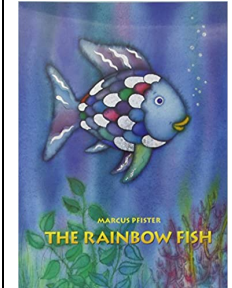
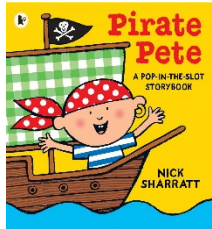


Nursery - Summer 2 - At The Sea



	Communication and Language	Physical Development	Personal, Social and Emotional Development
Prime Areas	<p>We will be using imaginative play in our At The Sea topic, and will think about maintaining conversations with people, and using talk to organise our thoughts. We will also spend some time asking and answering questions about moving to Reception, and will spend some time talking about our likes and dislikes with our new teacher for September.</p>	<p>This half term, we will be looking at the different skills we have learned throughout the year in our PE lessons and self-assessing where we think we need more practise. We will also ensure the children have developed the necessary skills to manage the school day ready for Reception.</p>	<p>As this will be our last half term in Nursery, we will spend a lot of time thinking about the changes that are coming in school. We will talk about the transition to Reception, what to expect from a new year group and meet our new teacher! We will summarise what we have learned throughout the year about our feelings and friendships to help us in Reception.</p>

Specific Areas	<p>For our final topic in Nursery, the children will be learning the story of Pirate Pete by Nick Sharratt. They will learn the story using a story map and actions, and will change parts of the story to make it into their own unique retelling. In their phonics, the children will continue their phase 2 learning as well as develop their confidence with writing their own name independently.</p>	<p>In our Maths sessions this half term, the children will be continuing to learn about numbers to five. We will be making amounts in different ways, matching numerals to quantities and looking at the more/less relationship between numbers and amounts within five. We will also solve real world problems relating to amounts and numbers within five.</p>	<p>This half term, we will be learning about pirates, boats, sea animals and how we can look after them, the beach, floating and sinking. We will be doing lots of exploration with water, observing physical changes that can happen to water and to objects that we put in water. We will also talk about different countries that have beaches and compare them to our own country.</p>	<p>This half term, the children will learn about sea shanties and will practise these with actions and instruments. They will be encouraged to perform these for their peers in Reception and Time for Twos. We will also be using a range of equipment and joining materials to make our own boats and test if they float or sink. We will look at how boats work and adapt these ideas for our own boats.</p>
